Playground Design Competition

We are delighted to have the chance to take part in an amazing competition run by Thermo Plastic Designs and Lines (TPDAL). One school is being given the opportunity to win a unique playground marking game designed by one of the children (estimated value £5,000). As a school we can only submit one entry so we have decided to run a school competition first in order to choose one design to be put forward into the competition.

The rules are simple. Ask your child to think of a fun game they would like to see on their playground. The most popular playground markings include games such as hopscotch, snakes and ladders and mazes. However, we would like to see something fresh and unique designed by the children themselves.

Entries will need to include a **colour drawing** of the game with the **rules** and **description** attached, with the pupil's name and age.

Once we have chosen the winning design from the school we will enter it into the TPDAL competition. They have CBBC presenter Rebecca Jackson, host of Ali-A's Superchargers to present the winning design, as well as the design being painted onto the school playground.

If you would like your child to take part please send in their colour drawing of the game, rules and description by 12th January 2018. We will then judge the entries and choose one to put forward into the main competition in June.
